What's your favorite part of your role as a PT?

I'm very fortunate to work exclusively with adolescent student-athletes as a sports PT. I enjoy watching their transformation from the beginning to the end of their rehabilitation process. In the beginning, they are often discouraged, nervous and unsure how to handle all the challenges that come with their injury. As they make progress in their rehabilitation, they learn how to take initiative, how to be resilient, how to help themselves, and they regain their confidence. They take control of their own destiny. I'm very grateful to be a guide that helps young student-athletes navigate this maturation process through their injury rehabilitation.

Did you play sports growing up?

I played basketball for my high school team and for an Asian American club team. On my high school team, I was a guard because I was one of the shortest athletes. On my club team, I played all positions because I was one of the only guys that could defend taller players. Because basketball was so competitive in Los Angeles, I had to focus on basketball year-round to keep a spot on the team and I could not risk getting injured in other sports. In another life, I would have also played soccer, volleyball and track.

What is a fun fact about you?

My oldest dog, Falco, is named after Falcon Heene (balloon boy from Fort Collins, CO).

What do you like to do when you are off the field?

I enjoy spending quality time with my wife, two boys and two dogs. We enjoy hiking and traveling. I also like to run half marathons and play basketball. When the boys get older, I'm excited to take them into the Rockies for backpacking, skiing and snowboarding.

What is the biggest piece of advice you would give a young athlete?

Take the time to appreciate the relationships you make in sports. Whether it means learning more about a teammate who looks different than you, an opponent whom you competed against, a coach who pushes you hard to get better or a referee who made a call that you disagreed with — there is always something to learn. You can ask about how they developed a specific skill, what their favorite food is (so that you can also try new flavors), what their family life is like or what drives them. Sports relationships can help teach you to appreciate diversity. They can also foster creative ideas to grow in your own ways.

What made you want to be a PT?

I suffered many ankle sprains while playing basketball in high school. These injuries caused me to change my game, as I wasn't able to reach my fullest potential. For example, I got very close to dunking many times, but then I'd suffer another ankle sprain that would set me back. We didn't have a PT or AT back then. I never found any solutions to reduce my chances of spraining my ankles until after college, when I learned about PT. After learning how to control my own destiny with different strategies to improve my ankle stability, I was motivated to help others in the same way.
