

SUPPORT "DON "T DIRECT

Research Insight: Children thrive with autonomy. According to Self-Determination Theory, ownership over their experience fuels motivation and enjoyment.

What You Can Do: Cheer for effort. Avoid coaching from the sidelines.

MODEL RESPECT & SPORTSMANSHIP

Research Insight: Kids mirror adult behavior, especially under pressure. Positive modeling builds social and emotional skills.

What You Can Do: Applaud both teams. Thank referees and coaches. Stay composed—even in tense moments.

3 CREATE A GROWTH-ORIENTED ENVIRONMENT

Research Insight: A focus on improvement rather than results builds resilience and long-term engagement (Carol Dweck, Growth Mindset). What You Can Do: Celebrate effort and learning. De-emphasize winning. Recognize progress.

FOSTER TEAM CULTURE & COMMUNITY

Research Insight: A strong sense of belonging increases enjoyment and retention in youth sports.

What You Can Do: Get to know other families. Show up for team events. Help build a welcoming and inclusive culture

NEW REFEREE ABUSE POLICIES

Pride Soccer Club Respects the Call

We, as a club, are committed to upholding the policy in **every effort to protect referees**, but also to **safeguard the integrity and sustainability of the game for generations** to come! Help us make this possible, we all have the responsibility.



The Penalties Matrix defines consequences associated with physical and non-physical offenses against Referees.

NON-PHYSICAL OFFENSES of gross misconduct, abuse, and / or assault

NON-PHYSICAL*	MIN. GAMES	TIME
Insuiting, Belittling, Insinuating or Taunting Behavior Undermining Referee Authority	2	
Harassment, Intimidation, Retallation, Abusive, or Threatening (Non Physical) Language	4	
Aggression, Attacking, Derogatory, Cyberbullying, Doxing or Threatening (Physical / Violence) Language	6	6 - 24 Months
Offensive or Discriminatory Act	10	12 - 24 Months

PHYSICAL OFFENSES of gross misconduct, abuse, and / or assault

PHYSICAL*	MIN. GAMES	TIME
Minor or Slight Deliberate Touching	3	1 - 6 Months
Pushing, Grabbing, Pulling, Squeezing, Pinching, Lightly Slapping, Use of Object in Non Striking Manner, or Physical Property Damage	10	6 - 24 Months
Hitting, Punching, Elbowing, Kicking, Biting, Spiting, Choking, Tackling, Throwing or Use of Object or Any Part of Body (Forearm, Knee, Head) in a Striking Manner		12 Months - Lifetime

(*) Disclaimer: These are only a few examples of abuse – other actions or statements may also fall into this category.

KEY PENALTY FACTORS

- Single offenses are at minimum the prescribed game penalty or time penalty for non red zone offenses
- Penalties can be both game and time depending on severity / circumstances
- Second time offenders receive double punishment
- Third time offenders receive a lifetime
- More than one offense at the same time is at least the punishment for the most serious offense
- Offenses against minors are automatically subject to a "minor multiplier" resulting in triple punishment
- One offense warning per league to be managed by states and leagues collaboratively
- Game consequences are inclusive of 1 game penalty for any red cards given
- Optionality for 50% penalty for first offense from a minor




(3) TRIPLE the penalty if against a minor

Ex - Non-physical, taunting to a minor referee = 6 GAME SUSPENSION (more than 1/2 CSA season)

CSA may have only 50% referees who are minors, but Pride's Recreational league has a overwhelming
